



Modern Slavery Act Statement

This statement is made pursuant to section 54(1) of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 (the “Act”) in respect of ExodusPoint Capital Management UK, LLP and its affiliate, ExodusPoint Capital Management UK Technologies, Ltd (collectively, “ExodusPoint” or “we”) in respect of the financial year ended 31 December 2025.

ExodusPoint Capital Management UK, LLP is a limited liability partnership incorporated in England and Wales. It is an investment management firm, authorised and regulated by the Financial Conduct Authority. ExodusPoint Capital Management UK Technologies, Ltd is a limited company incorporated in England and Wales.

References to the term “modern slavery” in this statement include slavery, servitude and forced or compulsory labour, and human trafficking, as defined in the Act.

ExodusPoint neither condones nor tolerates the presence of modern slavery in its business or its supply chains. As an investment management firm, we consider the risk of modern slavery taking place in our business and our supply chain to be low based on the nature of our operations and our supplier profile, including the types of services provided and the geographic location of suppliers in countries where the risk of modern slavery and human trafficking is low.

The goods and services we source in connection with the provision of our investment management services are primarily provided to us from the UK and are limited to areas such as professional services, real estate, facility management, office equipment, software and non-core ancillary services such as catering or cleaning.

ExodusPoint has policies and procedures in place to ensure adherence with the Act and applicable law, including bribery and corruption, money laundering, employment and discrimination, whistleblowing and escalation of staff concerns or issues. ExodusPoint’s Code of Ethics reflects its commitment to acting ethically and with integrity in all areas of its business and its supply chain.

Nonetheless, we take appropriate steps to detect and address potential modern slavery and human trafficking, or the presence of forced labour within any part of our business or supply chain. This is achieved via our procurement and vendor management onboarding process and by providing appropriate training on the requirements of the Act to staff involved in procurement and vendor management.

The effectiveness of these steps, along with our policies and procedures related to the Act are kept under periodic review.
